Diocese Bids Farewell to Bishop Peter



On Saturday 22nd May people across the diocese came together to watch Bishop Peter's farewell service from Wells Cathedral, witnessing him placing his staff on the altar, signalling the end of his seven years leading the diocese.

During the service Bishop Peter's wife Jane read Colossians 3, 12-17, there was a Reflection by Bishop Ruth Worsley, Bishop of Taunton, and songs from the pupils of St Mark's School, Worle.

In his sermon Bishop Peter said: "It has been an enormous privilege to serve as the 79th Bishop of Bath and Wells and I am so grateful for the welcome you have given me as I have travelled around, visiting parishes, schools and chaplaincies, and sharing in all that is happening across the diocese.

"As I come to retirement, I also want to thank everyone for the support and prayer you have given Jane and me since I was diagnosed with leukemia last year. At times it has been a hard road to walk, but your love and prayers have been more uplifting and encouraging than I can tell you. And we look forward, with faith and hope, to all that the future holds."
