APRIL Is Here...Spring is bursting forth with colour, as daylight is noticeably lengthening. Now sunlight is fuelling nature's energetic awakening. Now is time to dig, sow and start growing this

year's plants from seeds, corms, tubers or bulbs.

Growing healthy plants is key to our nation's food production on various scales, whether on farm, allotment, garden, greenhouse or window box. Nutritious crops are vital for the nation's health and there is plenty of evidence to highlight the importance of spending time outdoors and paying attention to living things, for our mental and spiritual wellbeing.

Backed by Food For Life Get Togethers and the Soil Association, Plant and Share month is a national campaign. Its simple goals are to bring people together through planting, cooking and sharing food. This builds care and community across generations, cultures and neighbourhoods. Also, it's raised awareness of the importance of growing plants for nutrition, physical activity and wellbeing.



Plant and Share Month is divided into 4 themed weeks:

1. **Growing for All** 1st-7th aims to make growing your own food is easy and accessible for everyone, whatever your space or experience.
2. **Growing to Eat** 8th-14th can combat rising food costs and shows growing food can be a fun way to enjoy delicious, nutritious food.
3. **Growing for Joy** 15th-21st enables wonders for wellbeing; plants bring colour, scent and wildlife.
4. **Growing for Nature** 22nd-30th feeds wildlife, refreshes soil, creates habitat.

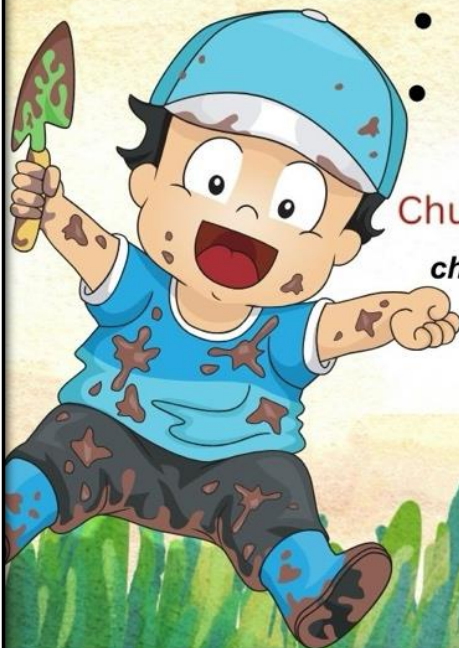
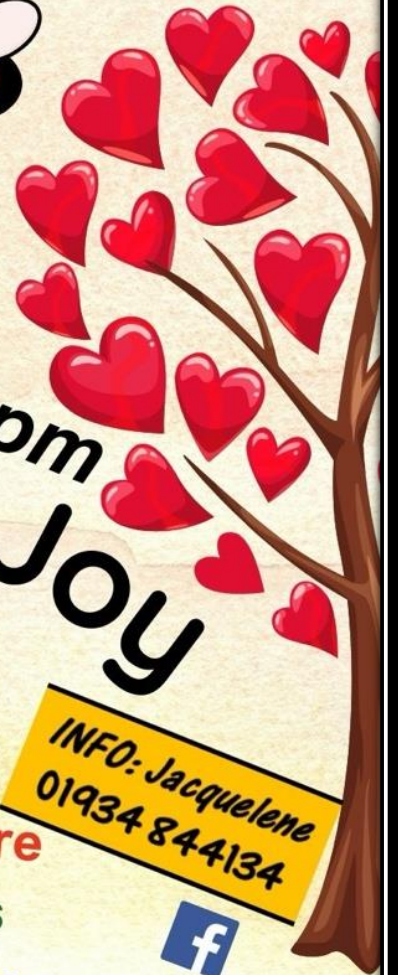
